

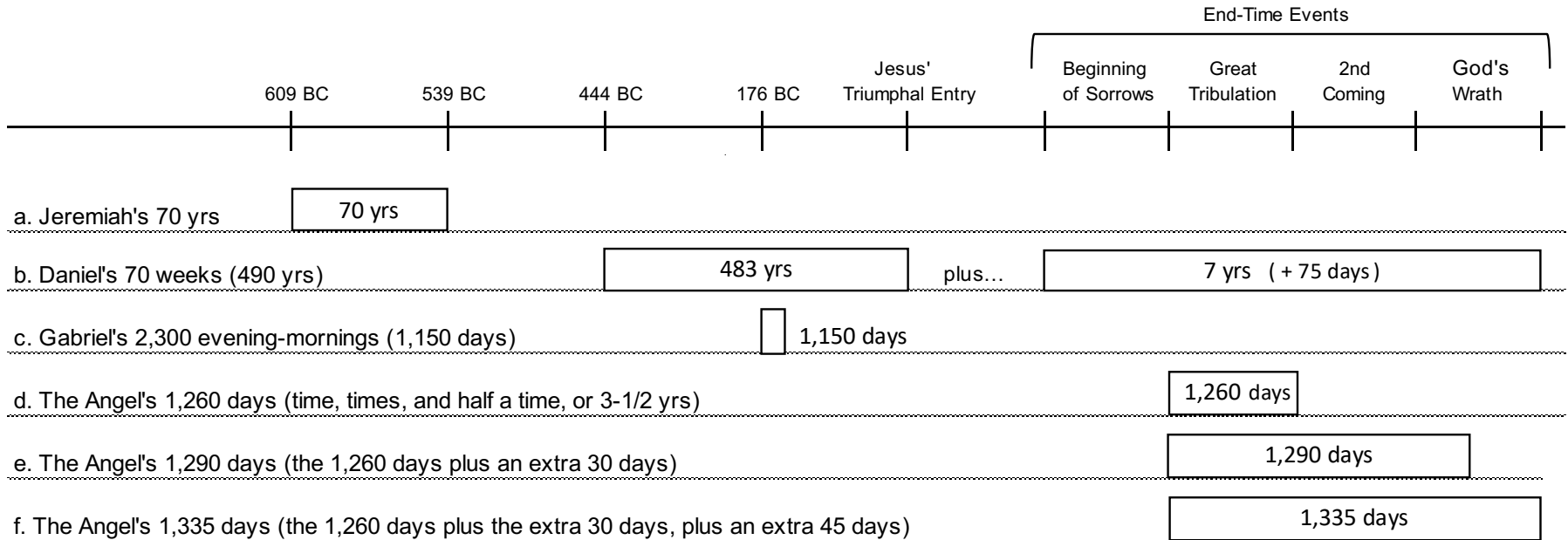
Timelines in the Book of Daniel

- b. Daniel's 70 weeks (Dan 9:24)
- c. Gabriel's 2,300 evening-mornings (Dan 8:14, 26)
- d. The Angel's 1,260 days (Dan 12:7)

- f. The Angel's 1,335 days (Dan 12:12)

The Scripture references to the left refer to prophetic periods of appointed time for the nation of Israel.

The simple graphic below illustrates when they happen throughout history and the end times.



Note: The Second Coming of Christ is shown to occur at the end of the 1,260 days (the Great Tribulation). During the extra 30 days and 45 days, Jesus will be gathering the saints and administering the wrath of the Father on the rebellious kingdom of the antichrist.

The wording in Daniel and Revelation suggest that the reign of Babylon, in the form of Mystery Babylon, is not yet complete. Its power and influence will again be seen during the Great Tribulation.
