Dan Ch 2 4 antichrist spirits are revealed to Daniel	Gold = Baylon. Nebuchadnezzar institutes imperial cult worship; is a type of antichrist. God saves 3 boys from the fire.	Silver=Medo-Persia. Darius demands worship, is a type of antichrist. Daniel does not comply; rescued from lions.	Bronze = Greece. Antiochus IV desecrates the temple. The Maccabees revolted; now celebrated by Hanukkah.			Iron- Islamic Empire. The brutal cult of Islam begins its radical mission of global domination. Shia & Sunni are divided.	This kingdom (iron & clay) will be the antichrist's imperial empire. The 10 toes are regional caliphs. See Psalm 83.	God's kingdom is established on the earth, crushing the antichrist and all antichrist spirits.
Dan Ch 7 4 beasts are 4 kingdoms shown to Daniel	One of the beasts (the winged lion) symbolizes Nebuchadnezzar and the kingdom of Babylon. Daniel serves him.	Another beast (carnivorous bear) is symbolic for Medo-Persia. Includes Cyrus/Darius. Persia is prominent.	The kingdom of Greece (4-headed leopard) includes Alexander the Great and Antiochus IV, a type of antichrist.			After these, a 4th beast (exceedingly dreadful, different from the others) is radical Islam that devours & crushes.	This 4th beast had 10 horns, plus a little horn, is the antichrist's imperialism through 10 caliphs. See Psalm 83.	The Ancient of Days comes. Judgment is passed in His favor & the saints possess this kingdom.
Dan Ch 8 Ram & Goat; Persia/Greece		The ram represents the combined dominion of the Medo-Persian empire.	The male goat is symbolic for the kingdom of Greece ruled by Alexander and his 4 generals.	Antiochus IV ascends to power. He invades the temple in Jerusalem and defiles the altar.			The antichrist is pictured here. Antiochus IV was a prefigured type of the antichrist.	
Dan Ch 11 Future Strife; North/South		Persia's last and most powerful king (Xerxes IV) tries to defeat Greece but does not succeed.	Alexander rises to power in Greece. His 4 generals and their descendants rule after his death.	Antiochus IV and his successors engage kingdoms in the region.			The antichrist magnifies himself as God. He will prosper until all decrees are finished.	

Dan Ch 2 - The legs of iron is not the Roman empire. They had many neurotic, egotistical emperors, but none that personified the antichrist spirit. The holy land is the emphasized location.

Dan Ch 7 - The 4th beast is not the Roman empire; this dream was about re-vealing four antichrist spirits. Scripture does not require the kingdoms to be successive.

Dan Ch 8 - Chapter 8 skips Rome. The Roman empire is not mentioned between Antiochus Epiphanes IV and the antichrist.

Dan Ch 11 - Chapter 11 skips Rome. The Roman empire is not mentioned between Antiochus Epiphanes IV and the antichrist.

The future rise to power of the antichrist and imperial cult worship is seen in all four chapters.
